What does the course contain:

The key concepts of science, management, dynamics, psychology, social interaction and the human spatial mapping of crowds, their possible causes and preventative measures, scientific theory and its many and varied applications. The programme has a focus on crowd behaviour, psychology, social interaction and human spatial mapping showing how the social and scientific elements are integrated providing a better understanding of visitor management and the management of crowded space.

This is delivered through knowledge and information of new technologies, proxemics, pressure and temperature, arrival, ingress, circulation, egress and departure as well as evacuation and crowd profiling

- Decision making, negotiation, communication and problem solving through the development of theoretical concepts and then putting them into practice
- Scenario based learning developing ideas and actions related to one or more major incidents in a real life situation
- The development of synergistic groups and working in these groups to solve a series of venue based problems in situ through table top exercises.

Overview

This unique four-day course, developed in partnership with Oncourse at the NEC, is taught entirely in a workshop environment where all theory learned is applied in a workplace situation and any assessment is linked to your job role. The course is in two parts, the first focuses on a number of areas: the management of crowded spaces, scientific notions of crowd management, human spatial mapping, crowd dynamics, decision making, problems solving and working in teams.

The second half of the programme provides real life and often real time situations either in the venue or in a specially constructed tabletop environment. Participants are introduced to a number of event-based issues and expected to create practical solutions to these.

From this course you will learn to:

- Make both simple and complex decisions using theory and practice in the event environment
- Understand the concepts related to crowded space, it's science and it's management
- Appreciate the way in which teams work together ot solve problems and to create innovative solutions
